# Portals. Lost in the Shuffle.

- Large portal application stacks too bulky
  - Original mission of portals is lost in arms race
  - Timelines not competitive with other web apps
- Agnostic is now an afterthought
  - Portals lack middleware and SOA focus
  - Too much focus on the vendor “stack”
- Portals can't keep up with business demands
  - Dynamic business content scales beyond IT SLAs
  - Thousands of sites & pages
  - Constant refresh of product, event, or service data

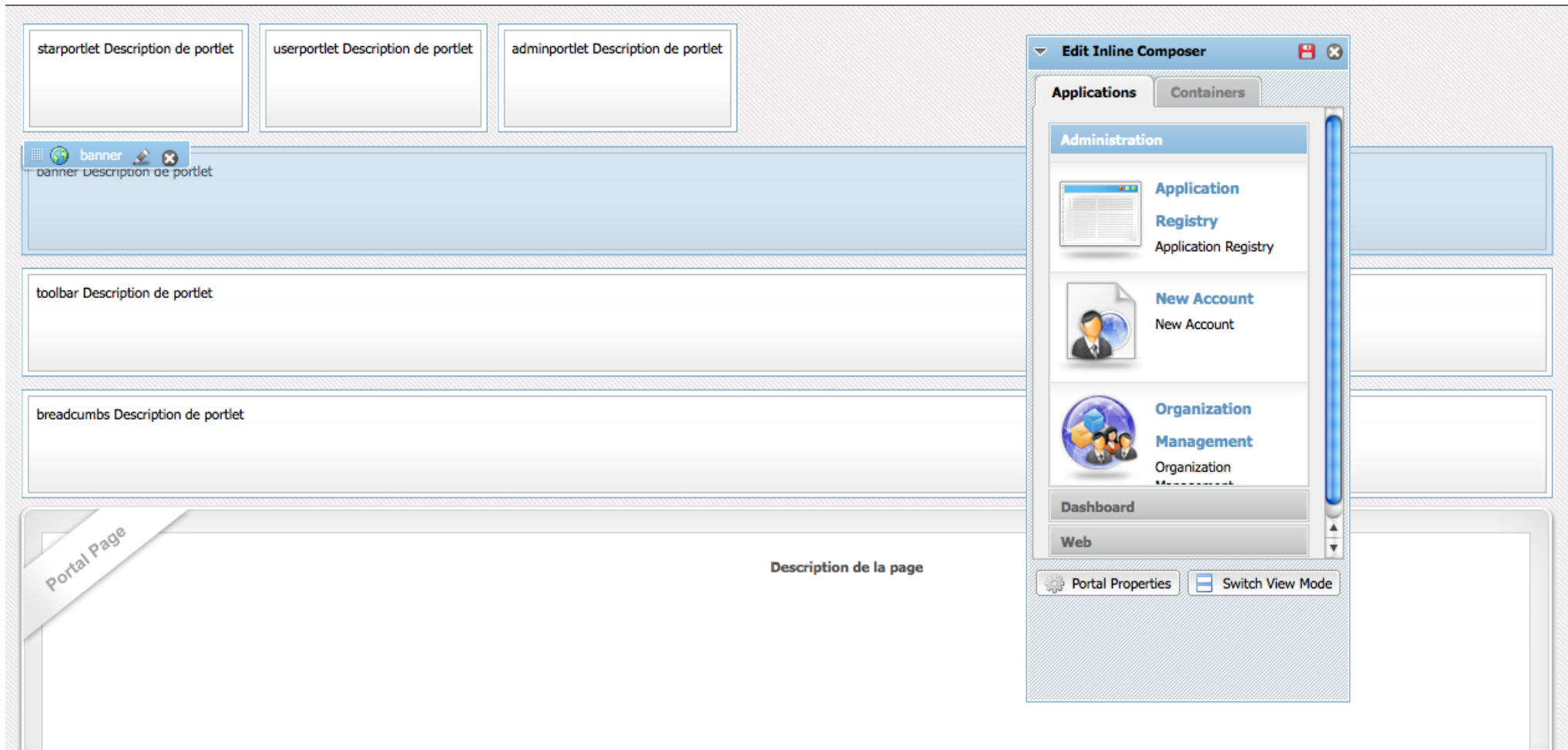

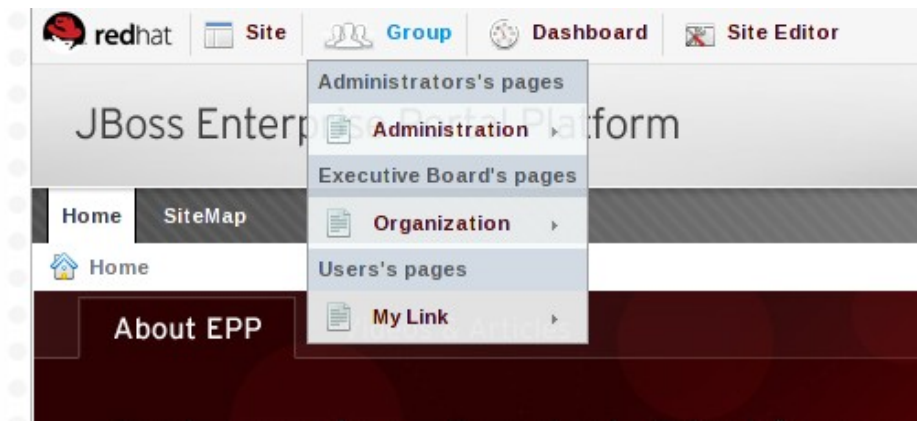

  - An option for fee add on to the JBoss EPP 5.1 distribution
  - Snaps easily into existing install via EAR file
  - Fully leverages the underlying JBoss EPP features
  - Distributes the effort of managing pages and content to LOBs
- New WCM features in Site Publisher
  - User-driven authoring & publishing
  - Search
  - Enhanced site templates
  - Web form authoring & content templates
