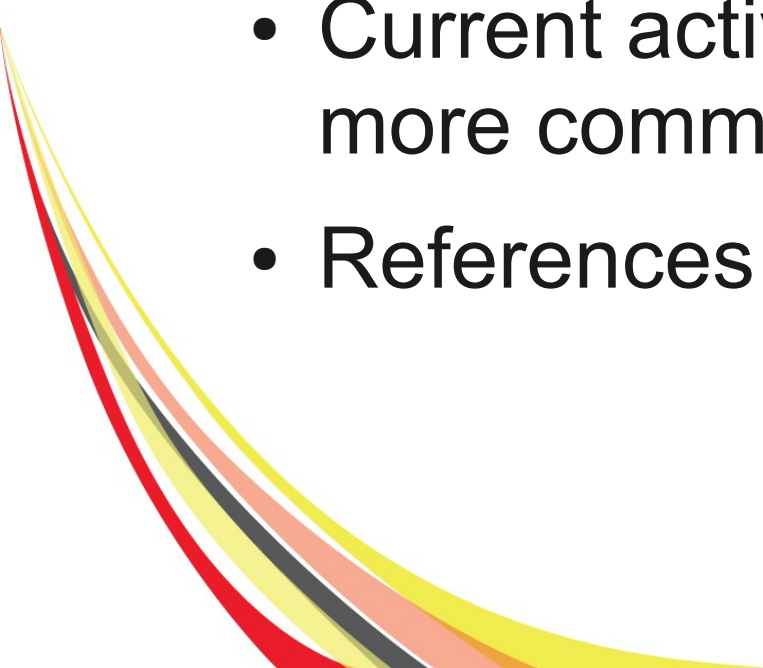

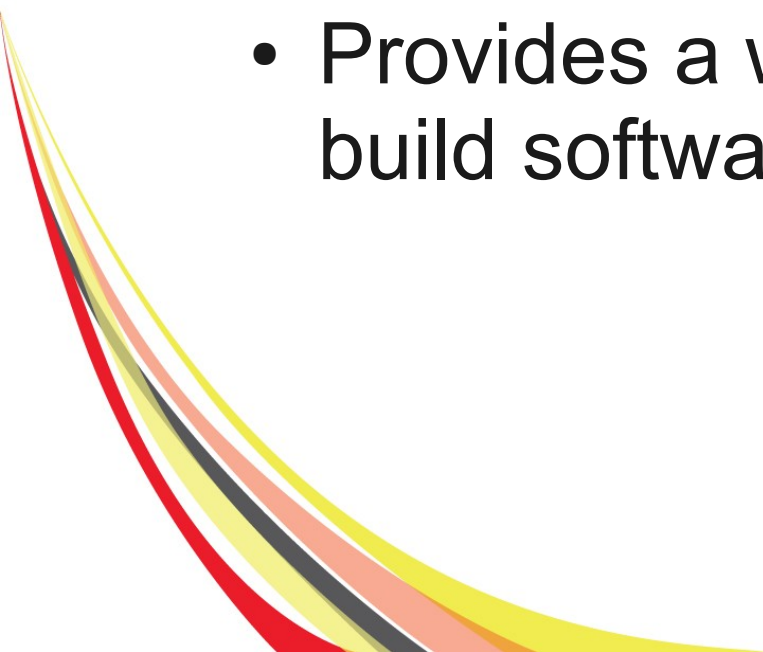

- Graduated October 2012
- Latest release 0.2.0-incubating

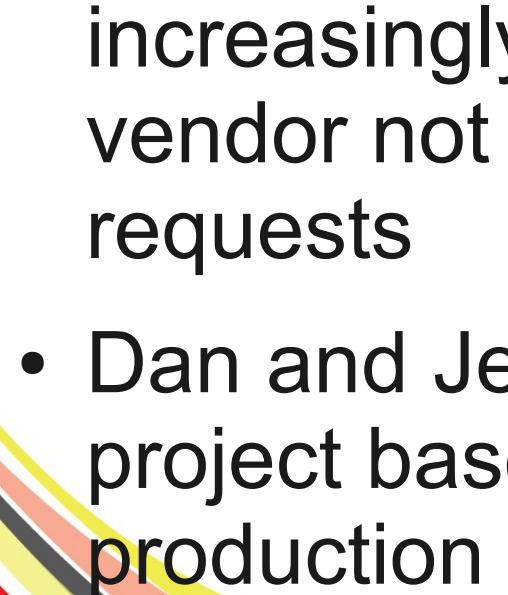
# What is Apache Isis and what it can do

- Apache Isis is for GUI as Hibernate is for persistence
  - Builds on top of the base concepts of Domain Driven Design (Object Model as key building block)
  - Provides a way to rapidly prototype and build software systems
