Manage SOLR Configuration					
Function	Description				
Manage SOLR Facet Groups	The Facet GROUP are, for example, COLOR, MATERIAL etc. Facet GROUPS are managed for each level of the Product Category structure. The function provides the ability to hide or show specific facet GROUPS and sequence the GROUPS within the faceted navigation panel.				
Manage SOLR Facet Values	The Facet VALUES are the values within a group, for example, VALUES of Red, Green, Blue within the GROUP Color. This function provides the ability to manage the sequencing of the Facet VALUES on a global basis by broadcasting to every Product. For specific Product level sequencing of Facet VALUES, use the Catalog / Product / Facet Sequencing function.

- The "standard" BigFish Facet Groups should be included on this display for ALL product categories. This includes:
 - FACET_GROUP_CATEGORY
 - FACET_GROUP_PRICE
 - FACET_GROUP_RATINGS
- Hide / Show should be controlled by manipulating the "thru" date
 - o Hide: thru-date = [system-date less one day]
 - Show: thru-date = null

Helper Text

- Edit Mode:
 - Facet Group ID is a read-only field
 - Action Button will display "Save"
- Add Mode
 - All attributes are available for editing
 - Action Button will display "Continue"
 - When adding a new Facet GROUP it is important that all subsequent relationships are known and resolved before completing the task
 - For this reason, this function will:
 - initially prompt for new Facet Group information, as shown above
 - then prompt for a list of VALUES to be entered
 - and finally, if there are existing products, prompt for Product level VALUE association
- Save (Edit Mode)
 - Validate data, save to the database, return to List screen with standard "Success message"
- Continue (Add Mode)

- Validation should be performed
- If valid:
 - Set all the attributes read-only
 - Disable the Back and Continue buttons
 - Display the VALUES component
- Validation

- "Save" button

 - DEV: see query below
- Screen is essentially the same as the "Manage SOLR Facet Values" function
 - "Swatch" image link is not available
 - Should be presented with 5 open rows initially

- Validation
 - See "Manage SOLR Facet Values"
- Actions:
 - "Back"

Actions
