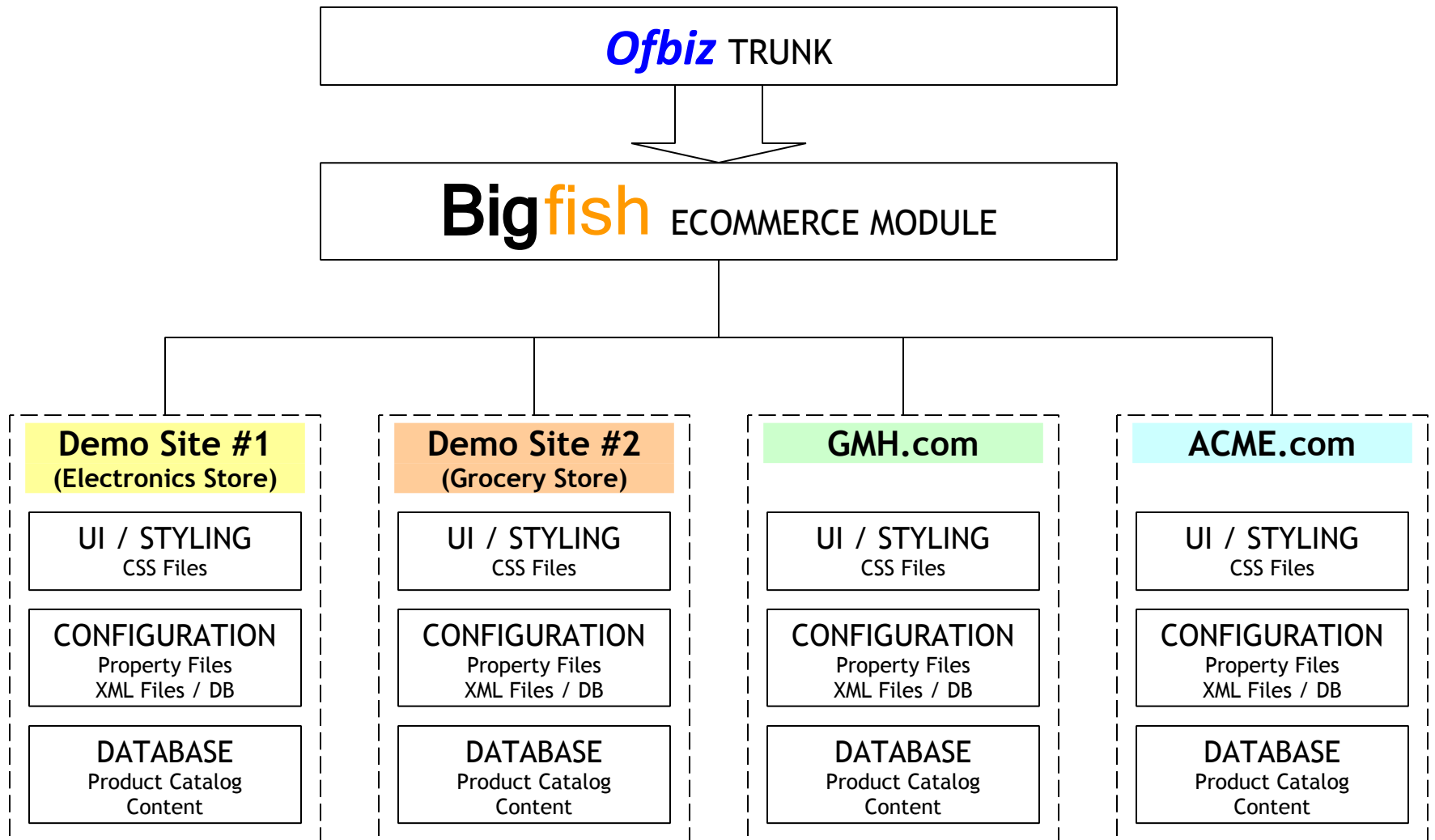

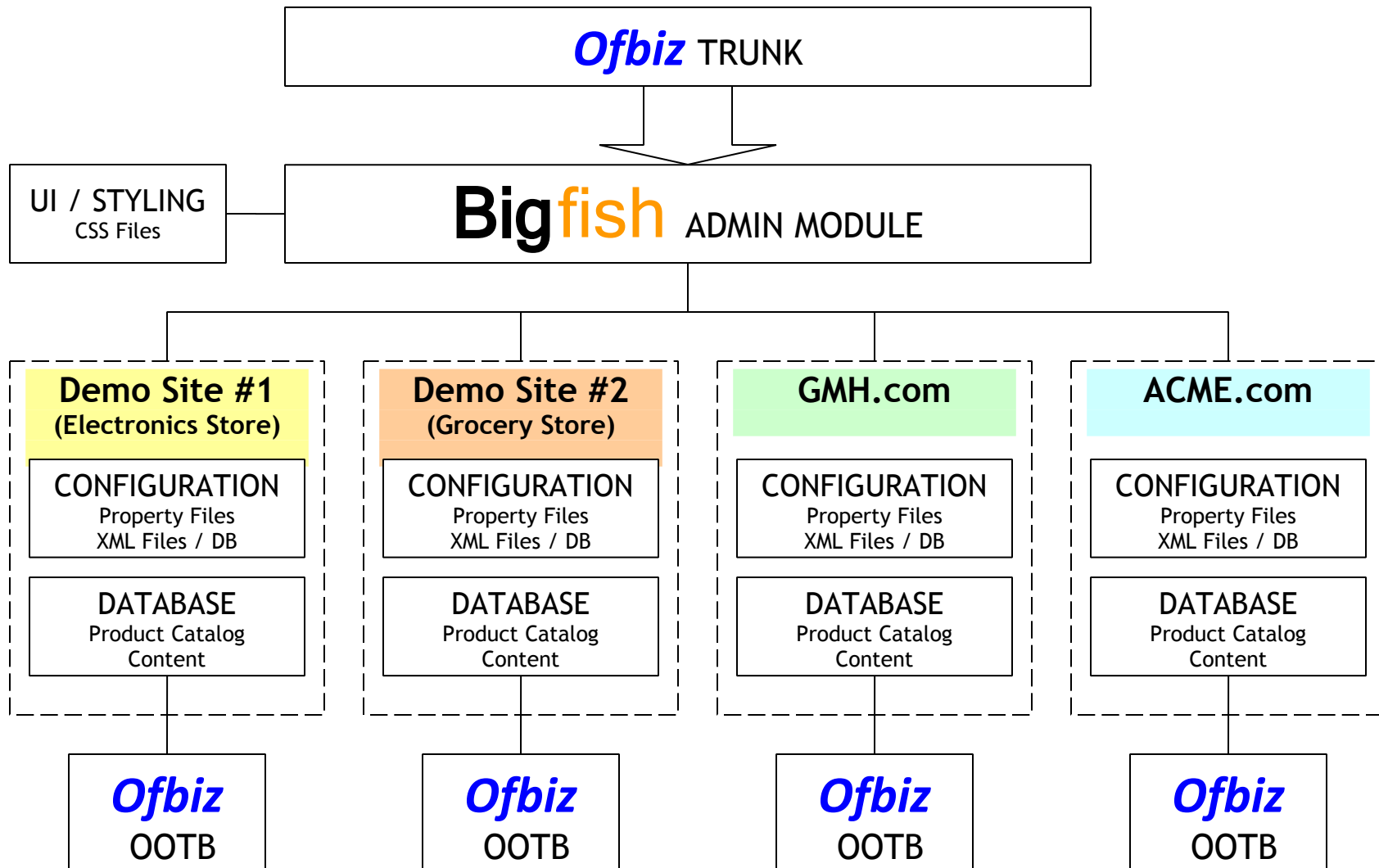
2 BF eCommerce



Keys

- OFBiz “trunk” to be disrupted as little as possible
- BF eCommerce Module is one set of Java / JSP
- All styling is delegated to the CSS, other configurations are driven from configuration files and database parameters

3 BF Admin Module



Keys

- OFBiz “trunk” to be disrupted as little as possible (same trunk as eCommerce Module leverages)
- BF Admin Module is one set of Java / JSP
- Styling is driven for a BF look-and-feel, no client specializations
- Configuration files for the client will be used as inputs; screens used to modify client specific configuration inputs will be consistent across all implementations
- Different results and content will be displayed in the Admin module, depending on the Database driving the application
