## 1 Modification History

---

## 2 Introduction

---

- This document will describe the multi-location capability of the BigFish platform
- Initially, this will include the ability for eCommerce customers to register using a foreign address, maintain their address book using a number of countries
- A change of country will impact the format of the address and telephone number

### 3 Processing Rules

---

- Whenever an eCommerce is prompted for an address, the ability to offer multiple countries is a requirement of the BigFish platform
- This option is to be parameterized, examples:
  - If a client can only ship within the United-States then an eCommerce customer will NOT be prompted for a country. The default will be set to the United States
  - If a client can ship to the United States and Canada, then only those two countries will be offered in the drop-down
  - If a client can ship worldwide, then all available countries will be offered
- Country processing is independent of currency requirements
  - It should NOT be assumed that just because a retailer can ship to both the United States and the United Kingdom that currency will change
  - It is more typical that a retailer will require payment in local currency
  - Currency is a separate issue.
- Selection of a country from a drop-down will modify the way that the form / display operates in regard to address and telephone number formatting.
  - It will NOT impact hide/show of specific attributes, this is a function of the DIV-Sequencing strategy

## 4 Key Parameters

---

### 4.1 Definition

- Entity X\_PRODUCT\_STORE\_PARM will manage whether the client implementation will support a "country" option; which country is deemed the default and which countries will be offered.
- Parameters are:
  - COUNTRY\_MULTI
    - A value of "TRUE" means that the client implementation offers a multi-country capability
    - A value of NOT "TRUE" will mean that the client implementation is restricted to a single country. The "country" drop-down will NOT be displayed.
  - COUNTRY\_DEFAULT
    - If the client implementation supports multi-country, this will indicate which country should be pre-selected in the country drop-down
    - If the client implementation does NOT support multi-country, this will indicate the default country format to be used
  - COUNTRY\_DROPDOWN
    - For a multi-country client implementation this will identify all the countries that should be supported
    - The list is a comma separated GEO-CODE country values
    - A value of "ALL" will offer all available countries in the drop-down

### 4.2 Examples

Client ABC: can ship to the the United States ONLY:

- COUNTRY\_MULTI = "FALSE"
- COUNTRY\_DEFAULT = "USA"
- COUNTRY\_DROPDOWN = "USA"

Client GMH: can ship to the United States and Canada.

- COUNTRY\_MULTI = "TRUE"
- COUNTRY\_DEFAULT = "USA"
- COUNTRY\_DROPDOWN = "USA, CAN"

Client XYZ: can ship to the United States, Canada and other countries.

- COUNTRY\_MULTI = "TRUE"
- COUNTRY\_DEFAULT = "UK"
- COUNTRY\_DROPDOWN = "USA, CAN, UK, GER, IND, CHN"

Note: values for countries use the Country-GEO-CODE. Values used this document are illustrative only and do not necessarily match those for the final implementation.

## 5 Supported Countries

---

An initial list of supported countries is as follows:

- Canada
- China
- France
- Germany
- India
- United Kingdom
- United States

**NOTE 7-Oct-2011: this is a partial list for the initial implementation. The United States and Canada have specific formats as defined in the next section. Any other country selected in the drop-down should use the "generic format".**

## 6 Country Specific Formatting Rules

---

### 6.1 United States (USA)

#### 6.1.1 *Input Rules*

- State drop-down should contain the complete list of US States

#### 6.1.2 *Display Rules*

- Display Format:

First + Last  
Address-1  
Address-2 (if available)  
Address-3 (if available)  
City, State Zip  
Country

- Example:

TUCSON, AZ 85705  
UNITED STATES



## 6.2 Canada (CAN)

- Province drop-down should contain the complete list of Canadian Provinces:

AB	Alberta
BC	British Columbia
MB	Manitoba
NB	New Brunswick
NL	Newfoundland and Labrador
NT	Northwest Territories
NS	Nova Scotia
NU	Nunavut
ON	Ontario
PE	Prince Edward Island
QC	Québec
SK	Saskatchewan
YT	Yukon

### 6.2.2 *Display Rules*

- Display Format:

First + Last  
Address-1  
Address-2 (if available)  
Address-3 (if available)  
City, Province + Postal Code  
Country

- Example:

JOHN JONES  
MARKETING DEPARTMENT  
10-123 1/2 MAIN STREET NW  
MONTREAL, QC H3Z 2Y7  
CANADA

Zip or Postal Code  
Country

## 7 Processing Examples

---

■ Client ABC: can ship to the the United States ONLY:

- COUNTRY\_MULTI = "FALSE"
- COUNTRY\_DEFAULT = "USA"
- COUNTRY\_DROPDOWN = "USA"

<b>Country</b>	[drop-down]	Is NOT offered since the implementation does NOT support multi-country
<b>Address-1</b>	[entry]	
<b>Address-2</b>	[entry]	
<b>Address-3</b>	[entry]	
<b>City</b>	[entry]	
<b>State</b>	[drop-down]	Offers US States since the DEFAULT country is "United States"
<b>Zip</b>	[entry]	

■ Client GMH: can ship to the United States and Canada:

- COUNTRY\_MULTI = "TRUE"
- COUNTRY\_DEFAULT = "USA"
- COUNTRY\_DROPDOWN = "USA, CAN"

<b>Country</b>	[United States]	IS offered since the implementation supports multi-country. In this example the drop down would contain "United States" and "Canada". The default selection is "United States".
<b>Address-1</b>	[entry]	
<b>Address-2</b>	[entry]	
<b>Address-3</b>	[entry]	
<b>City</b>	[entry]	
<b>State</b>	[drop-down]	Offers US States since the DEFAULT country is "United States"

If the customer selects "Canada" then the display would be alter as follows:

■ Client XYZ: can ship to the United States, Canada and other countries:

- COUNTRY\_MULTI = "TRUE"
- COUNTRY\_DEFAULT = "UK"
- COUNTRY\_DROPDOWN = "USA, CAN, UK, GER, IND, CHN"

<b>Country</b>	[United Kingdom]	IS offered since the implementation supports multi-country. In this example the drop down would contain all 7 initial countries with the "United Kingdom" selected as the default.
<b>Address-1</b>	[entry]	
<b>Address-2</b>	[entry]	
<b>Address-3</b>	[entry]	
<b>City or Town</b>	[entry]	
<b>State or Province</b>	[drop-down]	Canadian Provinces would be offered here

If the customer selects "Germany" then the display would remain the same since Germany also uses the "generic format".

If the customer selected "United States" then the display would alter as follows:

## 8 Future Specific Implementation Rules

---

**NOTE 7-Oct-2011: the BF platform should support US, Canada and a generic format as described above. Other country specific requirements will be implemented at a later date. This section should be ignored for now.**

- Two of either Address-2, Address-3, Zip/Postal, City/Town or State/Province must be entered
- This should apply to all other countries that may be offered by the client configuration
