2 Processing Rules

- The Quick-Look functionality is required to provide a customer with a fast way to see the product details when browsing products on the Product Listing Page (PLP)
- Upon hover-over a product image on the PLP an image/text component will be made visible
- The image/text needs to be flexible for each implementation
- On click the Quick-Look dialog will appear
- The Quick-Look dialog will effectively display similar details from the Product Detail Page (PDP) without actually leaving the PLP

■ Implementation

- o For the most part, the implementation is a UI / styling exercise
- The back-end simply needs to provide the additional details and imagery for the Quick-Look to operate correctly

Considerations

- The "features" displayed are client / product specific
- Alternate images, if loaded, should be available
- Add to Cart should always be available
- View Details should always be available


Parameters:

- OUICKLOOK ACTIVE:
 - Allowable values are "TRUE" and "FALSE"
- QUICKLOOK_DELAY_MS:
 - Time, in milliseconds, before the Quick Look icon is displayed
 - This value is also used as the delay, in milliseconds, to hide the Quick Look icon after the mouse has moved away from the PLP image
 - If this is set to 0 (zero) then show/hide functionality is not required, it is assumed that the Quick Look icon is always displayed



5 Visual Options

5.1 Standard Visual Options

■ All components of the PDP should be made available for potential inclusion in the QuickLook display

5.2 Special Component

- A special component that is used to redirect control to the PDP must be made available
- This should be able to be styled as a link ("See Item Details") or a button

5.3 DIV Sequencing

- Components to be managed should be the same as the PDP page, see spec BF-Product-Details-Page
- All components should be part of the <DIV> Sequencing scheme
 - o This will control the inclusion or exclusive in this function
 - This will control the default sequence of display
