 - June 2007: First release as part of WTP 2.0 release

Mozilla Eclipse Mashup

- New multi-platform SWT embedded Mozilla
- Using Xulrunner, the Mozilla and Firefox rendering engine
- Enables Web browser integration beyond the capabilities of the standard SWT Browser widget
