

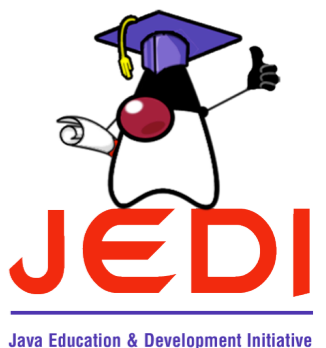

- driven by the community



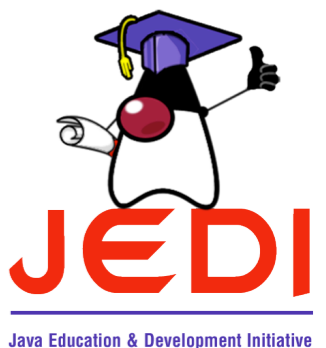
history

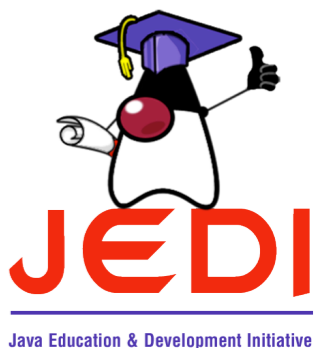

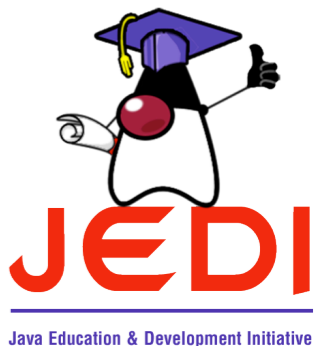
