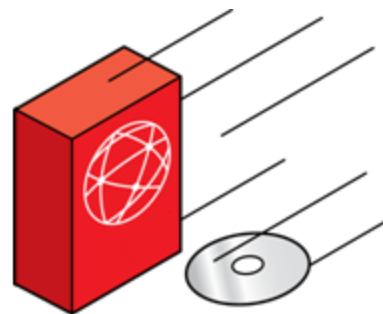
# What I'm Doing With The Fish
