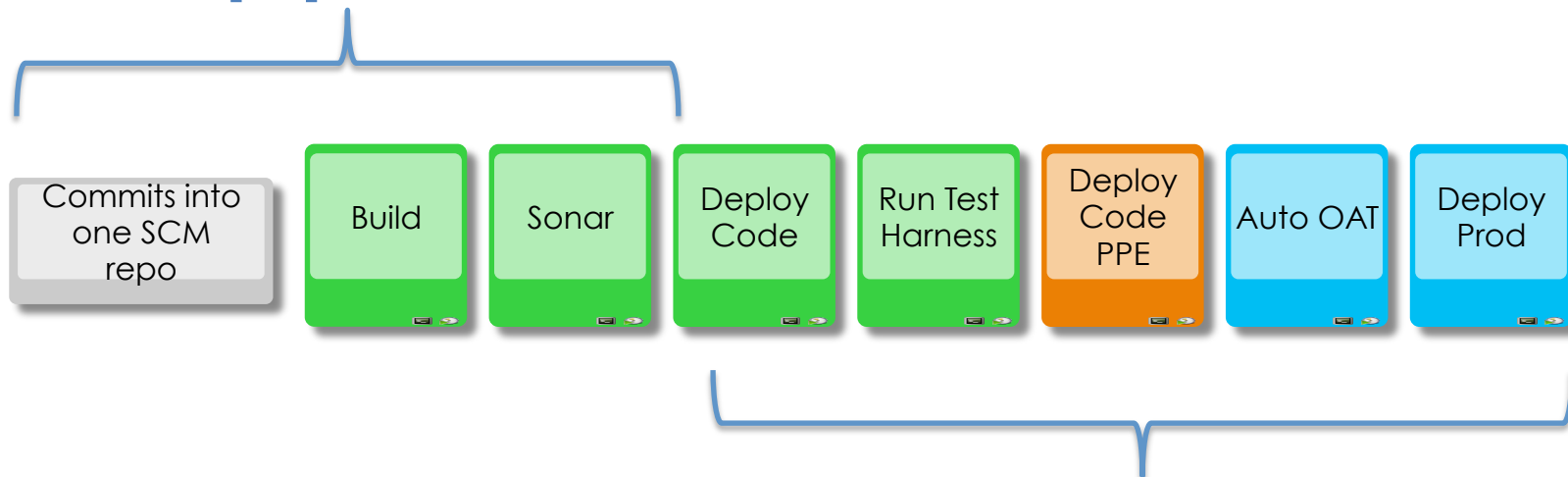

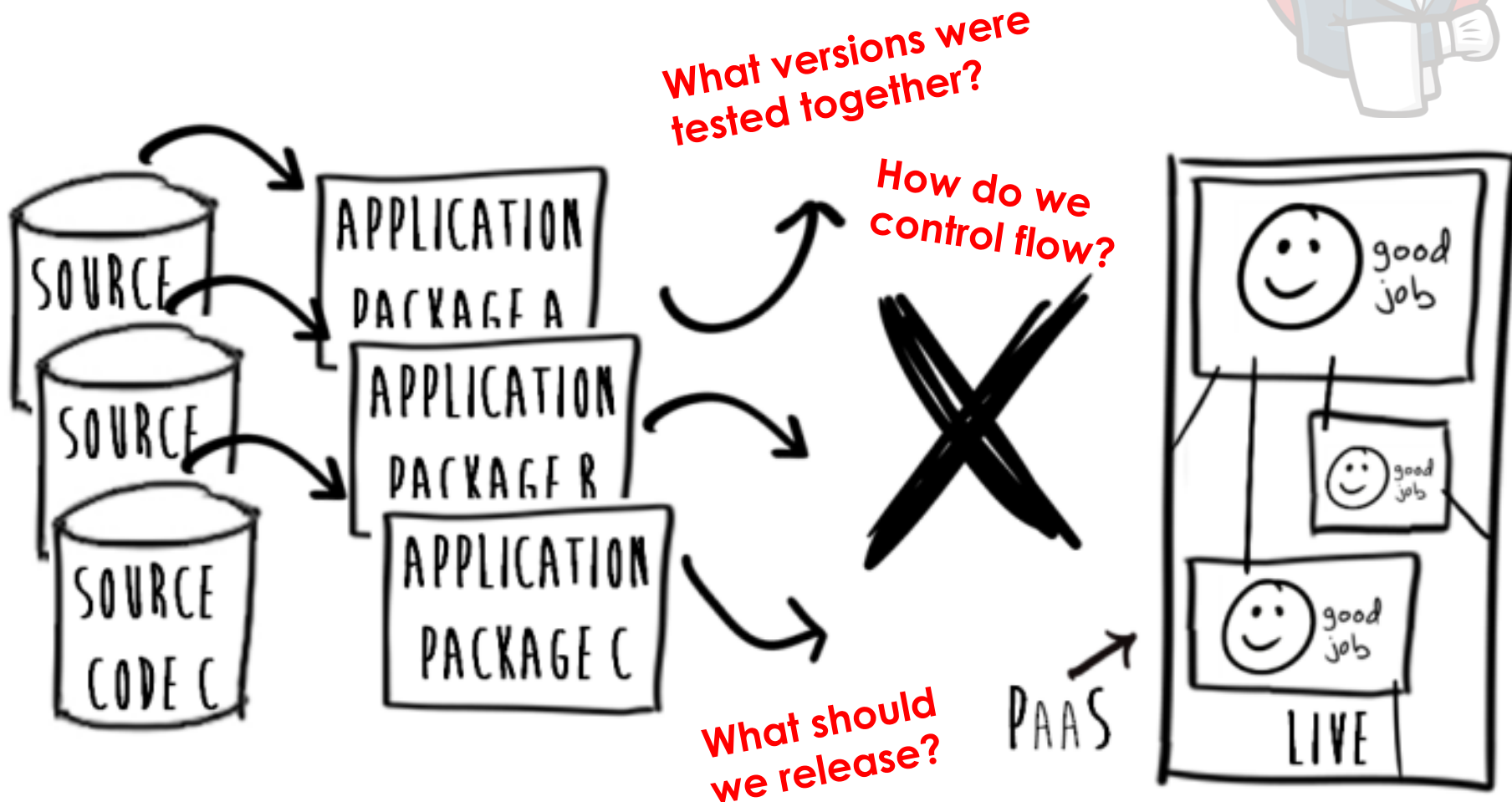

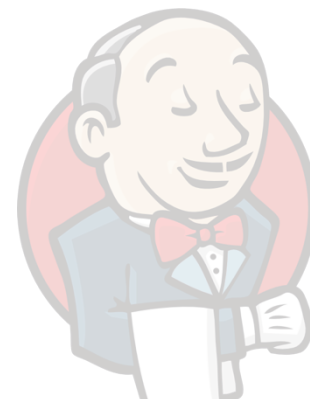

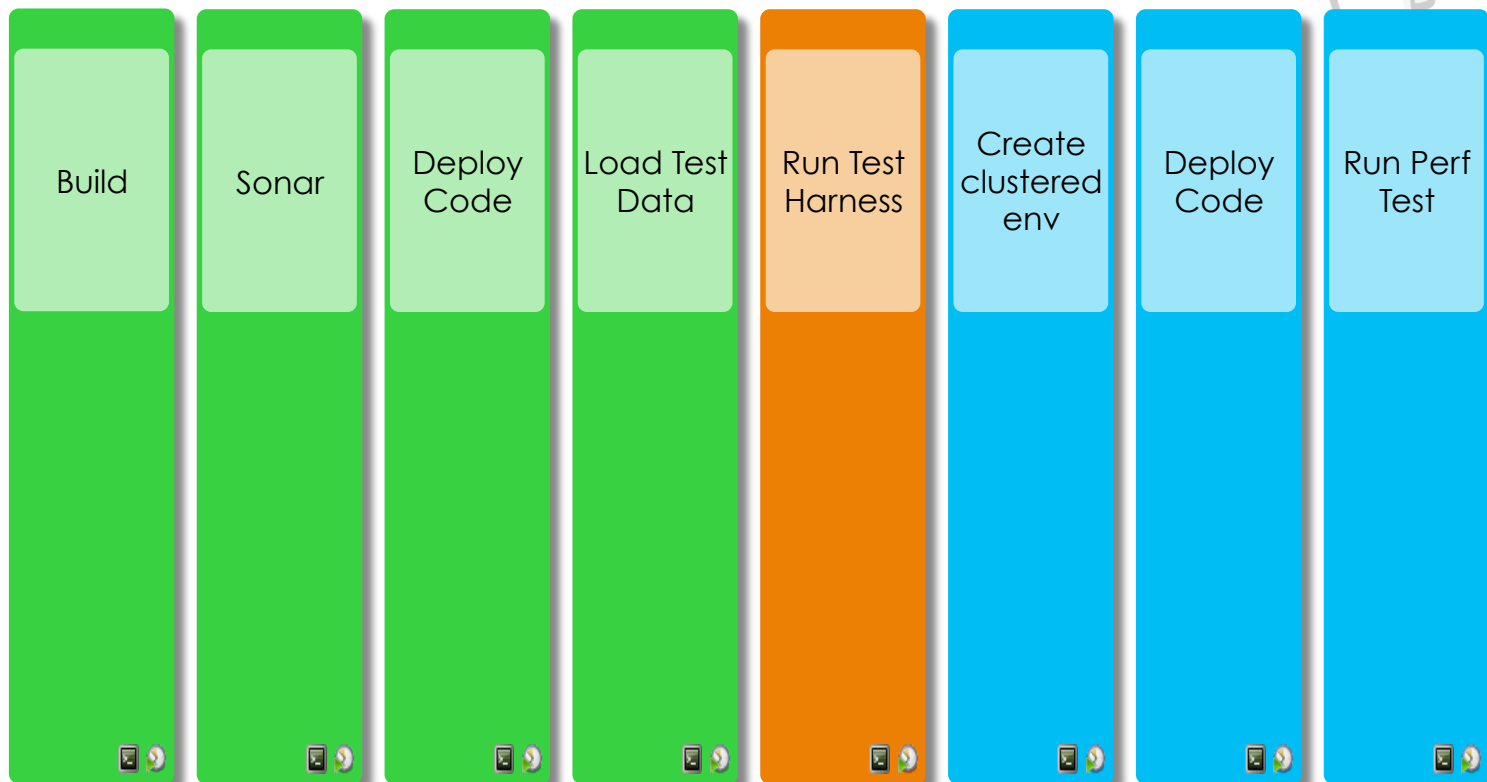
What to do we do when things get complicated?

Problem

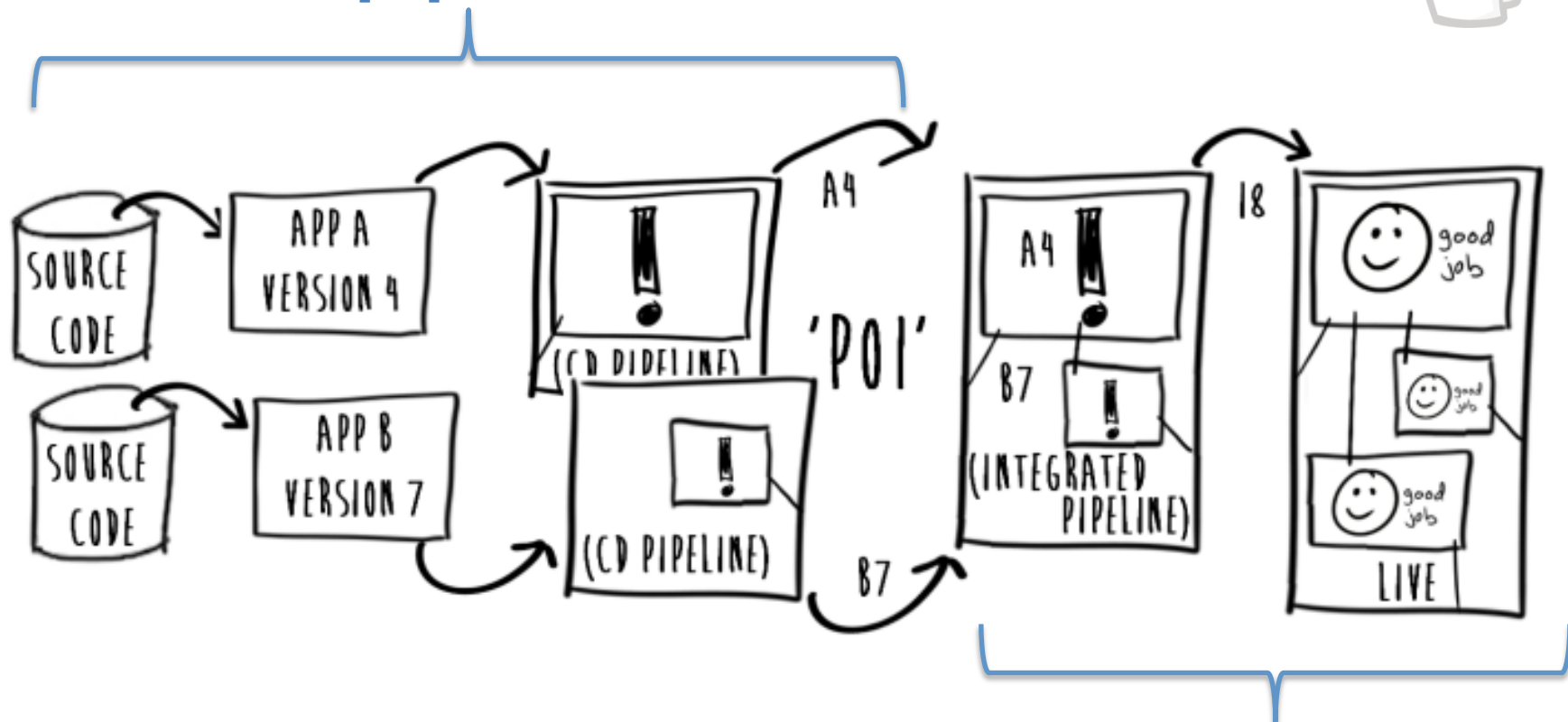


“We want a continuous delivery pipeline, but in practice the path to production involves carefully integrating lots of components along the way“

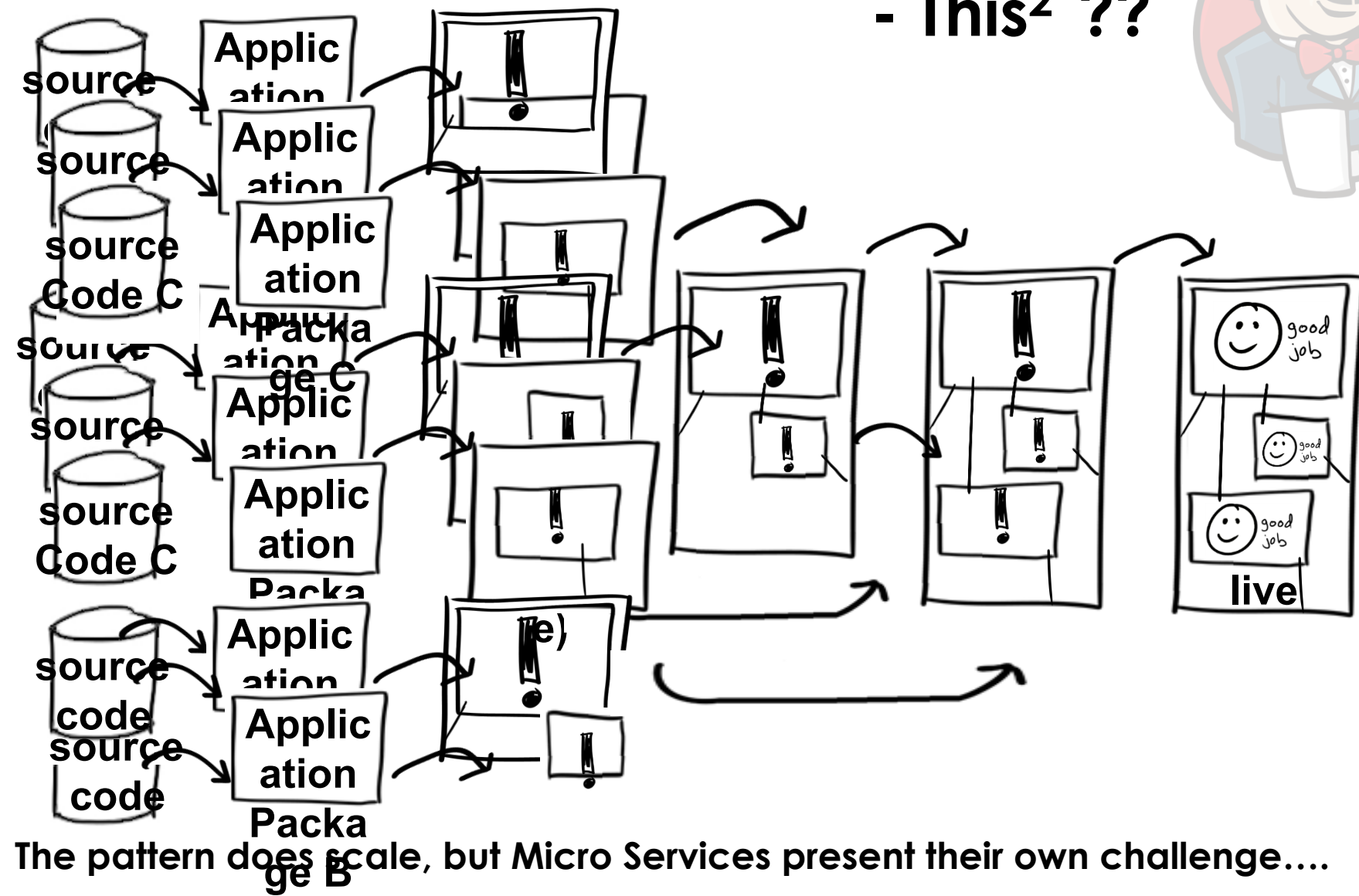
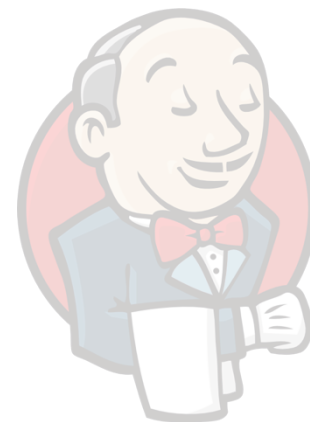

What about Micro Services?

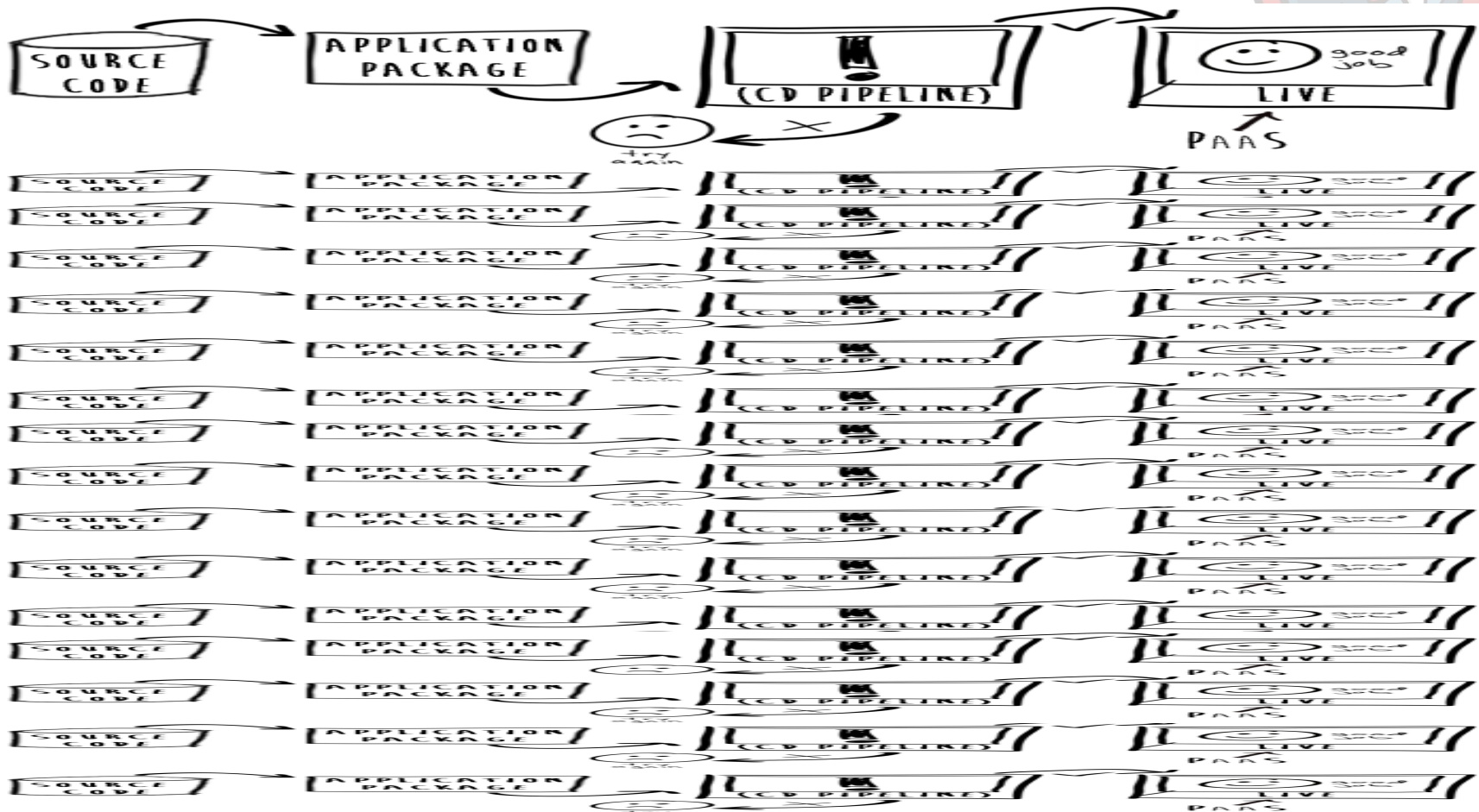

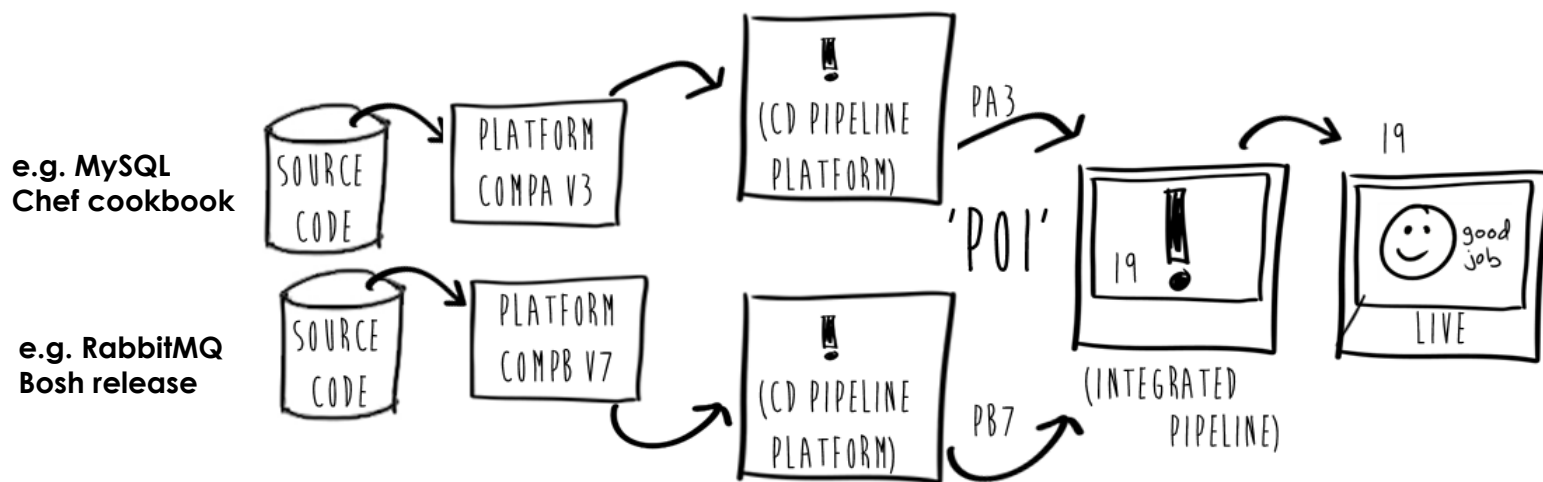
