- Serves multiple purposes
 - Organizes and unifies new & old tutorial/example material
- Clearinghouse for the project owner's presentations/articles
- Archives examples and info from old jini.org projects
 - > Different owners over time
 - > Different viewpoints, processes, mechanisms
- All related to Jini and JavaSpaces

The Primary Bodega Distribution

- Text-based installer java -jar install.jar
- Documentation
- Example code
 - Service based example (DevDeploy Stock example)
 - > JSK configurations from jini.org
 - TBD: Hello from starter kit & RayTrace from jini.org
- Development and deployment framework
 - > For building:
 - > ant **build.xml** files
 - > Shell/bat scripts *jant* or *jant.bat*
 - For execution: shell/bat scripts jrun or jrun.bat

Going Forward

- Emphasis on documentation and explanation
 - > Examples are for learning, not for demo
 - > Code does not run right out of the box, must be built first
 - > Emphasizes development, deployment, configuration
- Will add more documentation and example code as time permits
 - > The Bodega distribution is a work in progress
- Will add new presentations/articles when appropriate
- No intention to update/maintain the archived material
 - > Provided primarily for reference
 - Select examples may be integrated into Bodega dist.

Walking Through The Distribution

- Install the Bodega distribution
 - https://bodega.dev.java.net/download/download-info.html
 - Download the file install.jar
 - > From command line: java -jar install.jar
- Build the Bodega distribution
 - > From the command line
 - >cd <installDir>/example
 - >bin/jant
 - >bin/jant jars
- Use/explore the Bodega distribution
 - > Browse the documentation
 - > file:/<installDir>/example/index.html
 - > Run the example applications experiment
