



- * Sale Order Line









Incoming Shipments


Receive goods directly in stock: 1 step





Incoming Shipments


Unload in input location then go to stock: 2 steps





Incoming Shipments


Unload in input location, go through quality control then go to stock: 3 steps





Outgoing Shippings


Ship directly from stock: 1 step





Outgoing Shippings


Bring goods to output location before shipping: 2 steps: (Pick – Ship)



Logistic strategies on locations

- Removal strategy:
 - FIFO: First In First Out. -> Based on move dates
 - LIFO: Last In First Out. -> Based on move dates
 - FEFO: First Expiry First Out. -> Based on Expiry dates of Lots.


