README.macos - Perl under Mac OS (Classic)

**SYNOPSIS**

This document briefly describes perl under Mac OS (Classic). If you are running perl under Mac OS X, you don't want to be here (unless you are in the Classic environment under early versions of Mac OS X).

When we say "Mac OS" below, we mean Mac OS 7, 8, and 9, and *not* Mac OS X.

**DESCRIPTION**

The port of Perl to Mac OS was officially removed as of Perl 5.12, though the last official production release of MacPerl corresponded to Perl 5.6. While Perl 5.10 included the port to Mac OS, ExtUtils::MakeMaker, a core part of Perl's module installation infrastructure officially dropped support for Mac OS in April 2004.
